

WHAT IS PAYROLL GIVING?

Payroll Giving is a simple and effective way for you to donate regularly to benefit the work of The Centre. It is as simple as pledging a nominated amount (from as little as \$2 per fortnight) to be deducted from your pay.

WHAT'S IN IT FOR YOU?

All donations over \$2 are tax deductible and received free of cost, which means less is spent on fundraising and more to benefit our clients.

If just 10 per cent of the Australian Workforce donated \$5 a week from their pay through workplace giving, an extra \$250 million per year would be raised for groups like ours. (Based on ABS Australian market statistics March 2005)

The Centre's Payroll Giving Programme is a popular initiative that has been running for a numbers of years. It raises \$50,000 annually from the regular support received from employees of 70 local businesses, including staff from The Centre, \$10,000 of this regular income comes directly from our own staff which is outstanding.

HOW DOES YOUR SUPPORT HELP PEOPLE WITH CP?

Financial assistance is vital to the ongoing work of The Centre. Payroll Giving funding enables us as an organisation to better plan activities, goals and budgets based on a regular flow on income. This means greater outcomes can be achieved for our clients.

Payroll Giving donations makes it possible for us to receive regular, stable and on-going funding at much lower administrative costs – a preferable alternative to expensive fundraising activities.

WHAT HAPPENS AT TAX TIME?

A record of your donations across the year will be maintained by our Payroll Office. These payments will appear on your group certificate and reduce the amount of tax you pay each year.

IT'S AN EASY WAY TO GIVE

Payroll Giving does not require a lot of time or effort to setup. Once set up the deductions are made automatically each pay period
